Training. Supervision. Unique Clinical Experience. The Elizabeth Hospice hosts a comprehensive clinical counseling program to train psychotherapists in all aspects of grief and loss. We offer an 18 month clinical experience -- that provides training to developing therapists who are interested in the field of grief, loss and life transition.

Through our Center for Compassionate Care, the professional clinical staff supervise therapists, serve as mentors and share their expertise. Therapists have the opportunity to work with a diverse population of adults, children, couples, families and groups -- supporting the family system before and after our patient's death. Internship experiences include: individual and family counseling in home or office settings, school based grief groups on campus, collaboration with the hospice interdisciplinary teams; support group facilitation or workshops and special grief events for our community. In addition to the clinical supervision and training, the value of the experience is having the honor of making a difference in someone's ability to move through their grief.
