## Important Facts - Quito



- **High Altitude:** Quito, at 2,850m (9,350ft), is a high-altitude capital; hydrate to avoid sickness.
- **Historic Center:** UNESCO-listed colonial area with churches, plazas, and cobblestone streets.
- **Mitad del Mundo:** Monument on the equator; stand in both hemispheres, visit Intiñan Museum.
- **TelefériQo:** Cable car up Pichincha Volcano for stunning Andes views at 4,100m (13,450ft).
- **Local Cuisine:** Try loco de papa, ceviche, empanadas at Mercado Central or La Mariscal.

## Important Facts – Galapagos



- **Unique Wildlife:** Home to endemic species like giant tortoises, marine iguanas, and blue-footed boobies, best seen on guided tours.
- **Protected Ecosystem:** A UNESCO World Heritage Site and national park, with strict regulations to preserve its biodiversity.
- **Volcanic Islands:** Over 13 main islands, including Isabela and Santa Cruz, formed by volcanic activity, offering dramatic landscapes

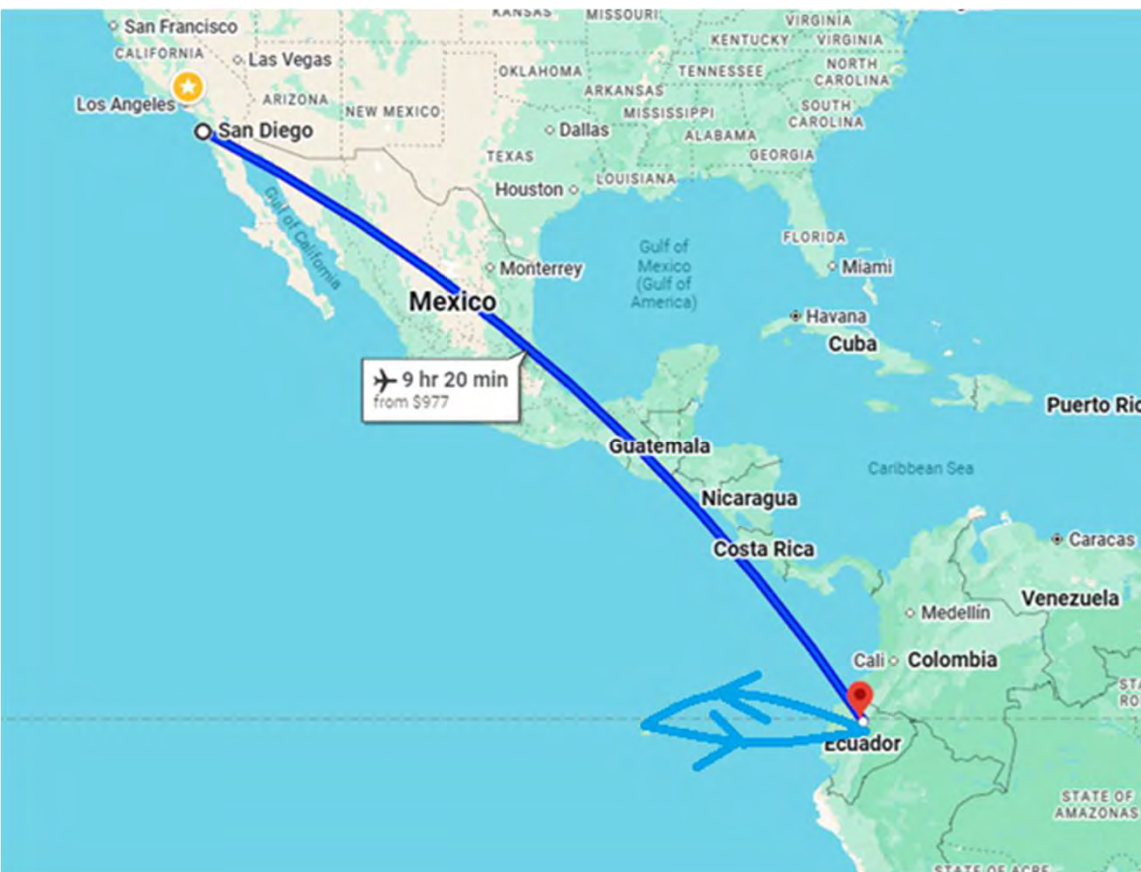
